Our mission is to provide meaningful, impactful educational experiences for all ages throughout the year. Instead of one day and one event, we invite you to celebrate the Earth at several smaller, student and family-centered events.

Temple Ambler EarthFest is expanding substantially in 2020. The need to share ideas about sustainability and protecting and preserving the environment is critical, now more than ever. Temple Ambler EarthFest will host a variety of events, in cooperation with the Ambler Arboretum and other partners, designed to get people thinking about and connected to the world around us.

EarthFest Presents events are designed to provide more personalized opportunities to interact with our exhibitors and students to get hands-on with citizen science. We will be inviting visitors to stargaze in April, celebrate Earth Day in May, campout on campus in July and explore all life in our woods in September!

EarthFest Presents 2020 Programs

Scheduled 2020 programs include, but are not limited to:

Read Across America: The Lorax (March 2, 2020): K-3

Hosted in partnership with the Ambler Arboretum of Temple University, we will welcome students for a reading of *The Lorax* amid our plants and trees in the campus Greenhouse. Using streaming services, schools will also join us via Zoom and YouTube to participate.

Reach for the Stars (April 3/October 2020): All ages

We will look for various objects in the sky and learn how to tell one from the other. We will also highlight the importance of dark skies to animals and the environment and learn how you can help keep the skies dark. Temple Ambler hosts these special stargazing events in cooperation with the Delaware Valley Amateur Astronomers and the Bucks-Mont Astronomical Association.

Celebrating Earth Day (May 1, 2020): K-5 (middle and high school students participate as exhibitors) The mission of Temple Ambler's annual Earth Day event is to promote environmental awareness using sustainable concepts, methods and practices to protect and preserve our environment.

Great American Campout (July 19 and 19, 2020) All ages

The National Wildlife Federation's Great American Campout is a celebration of camping as a way to connect with nature and wildlife. Temple University Ambler hosts a campout for new and experienced campers. Visitors spend the night tent camping, going on nature walks, and enjoying stargazing.

Fall BioBlitz 2020 (September 18, 2020) Age group to be determined

A BioBlitz is an event that focuses on finding and identifying as many species as possible in a specific area over a short period of time. At BioBlitz, scientists, families, students, teachers and other community members work together to get an overall count of plants, animals, fungi and other living creatures. Held in partnership with the Ambler Arboretum of Temple University.

Green Careers Fair (September 18, 2020) College students

Students will have the opportunity to meet with and learn from representatives from a variety of green industry fields including conservation, horticulture, landscape architecture, planning, urban farming, and more. Held in partnership with the Ambler Arboretum of Temple University.

Sustainability Action Day (October 16, 2020) Grades 6 to 8

Students will get hands-on during a special service project designed to help preserve biodiversity at Temple University Ambler. Students will learn about invasive plants and why they create problems for indigenous plants and ecosystems. Students will then learn how to successfully remove invasive species. This program is being held in partnership with the Ambler Arboretum of Temple University.

Science of Scary (October 18, 2020): All ages

All animals and insects, no matter how creepy or crawly, serve an essential purpose in their ecosystems and increase biodiversity. Connect with the world around you by learning about skunks, spiders, predatory birds, snakes, sharks, storms, toads and carnivorous plants to name a few! The event includes fall snacks, crafts and more. the Science of Scary is a family-friendly event designed to help learners and citizen scientists of all ages gain a deeper understanding of the wonders of nature and the amazing things that may be found right in their own backyards.
